The Government of Barbados through the Ministry of the Environment, National Beautification, Green and Blue Economy has received loan funding in the amount equivalent to US \$50,000,000 from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB). The Government intends to apply the proceeds to the contracting of consulting services, goods and works to be procured under the Climate Resilient and Sustainable Integrated Coastal Zone Management (CRS-ICZM) Programme. The Programme will also be jointly financed with The Government of Barbados. Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's eligibility rules and procedures.

The objective of this programme is to improve the resilience of the country's coastal zone to climate risk and promote climate-resilient economic development. The specific objectives are to: (i) reduce coastal erosion and flooding in coastal areas; (ii) improve the community and tourist value of coastal areas, including providing better accessibility for persons with disabilities; and (iii) improve the technical capacity and governance of the country's ICZM public policy to address climate resilience.

The programme encompasses the following two (2) components:

- 1** Integrated coastal infrastructure development
- 2** Strengthening technical capacity and ICZM public policy governance

The following is a general description of the procurements planned for the programme:

- Coastal infrastructure works at the following sites:
 - Clinketts, St. Lucy
 - Sand Street, St. Peter
 - Mullins to St. Peter's Bay, St. Peter
 - Rockley to St. Lawrence Gap, Christ Church
 - Oistins, Christ Church (also includes terrestrial drainage improvement works)
- Enhancing climate and disaster risk information analytics by upgrading the National Coastal Risk Information and Planning Platform
- Implementing ecosystem accounting in the central accounting processes of the Government of Barbados
- Training in coastal engineering, numerical modelling, and priority technical subjects
- Conducting community awareness-raising campaigns, with a focus on gender and persons with disabilities
- Purchasing of vehicles
- Purchasing of wave monitoring equipment

In this programme the procurement processes of contracts financed by the Inter-American Development Bank will be conducted in accordance with the Policies for Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (GN-2349-15), July 2019 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies. Consulting services will be selected and contracted in accordance with the Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (GN-2350-15), July 2019.

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the Inter-American Development Bank's international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures, will be published as they become available. For goods, works or consulting services expected to cost an amount equivalent to US \$200,000 or more, a request for expressions of interest for contracts will be advertised in UN Development Business and Inter-American Development Bank's Web Site, the Caribbean Community Public Procurement Notice Board, the Barbados Nation and the Barbados Advocate News Paper.
